Our Early Learning Time is on Thursday, January 23rd ! – S.T.E.M. is the theme.

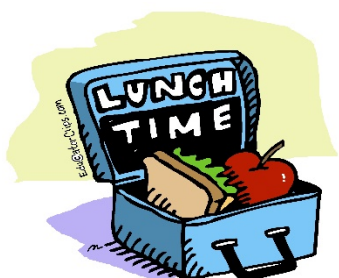
