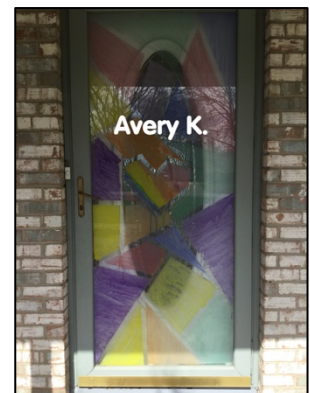

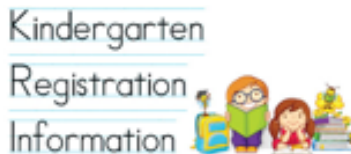

Parents: If you have a child, or know someone that does have a child, that will be ready for kindergarten in 20-21, please register at this time. You may send an email to Mrs. Magurany at carol.magurany@ptsc.k12.in.us

Parents: With the increased traffic on Schoology, slow and down times may occur during your Elearning schedule. Please know that staff is aware and we hope that you will try again at a different time in the day if necessary. Our IT department is in communication with Schoology and they are working together on the issue.



As the safety of all of our PTSC families and staff are top priority we have laid out a safety plan that we will need everyone to adhere to the rules. Our plan is to prepare meals on Mondays, pick-ups will take place on Tuesdays at Porter Lakes Elementary (208 South 725 West Hebron, IN 46341) from 10am to 12pm. We will be able to provide 5 breakfast and 5 lunches per child in the home (18 and under) at no charge to our families.



Below please find the steps we need you to take during meal pick up to keep everyone safe.

- When entering the parking lot please stay to the right and form 1 line of cars.
- Please have a sign in your front window with the name of 1 of your children and the school they attend.
- When you reach the front of the line please hold up fingers showing the number of children (18 and under) in your home and pop your trunk.
- Please make sure your trunk has room for us to put all the food in.
- A gloved employee will place the meals in your trunk, close the trunk and wave for you to leave. (for safety please do not exit your vehicle)
- If your child has allergies, please check all food labels before allowing them to eat. Some of the food we will be handing out will need to be temperature controlled. Please make sure you place these items in the fridge within 2 hours of pick up for safe consumption.
